**Project Overviews & Outcomes**

The Endowment's Board of Directors in its first in-person meeting (2.19-20.2007) set a number of priorities for programmatic investments. Staff was directed to flesh-out issue papers on each area with proposed investments for review and consideration at the Board's next meeting. At that meeting (June 18, 2007), the Board opted to conduct a national survey and hold a national convening/workshop to test Board ideas and concepts against broader input.

Issues generated by the Board and those identified in the national survey were used to define content parameters for the national workshop held in Greenville, SC. The Board then used the results of the workshop at its November 2007 meeting to establish initial programmatic investment priorities. The results of the workshop were published in a report entitled, "[Mapping a Course of Action](#)."
