Project Overviews & Outcomes

Endowment staff participated on the Green Building Strategy Group Board that was designed to coordinate activities of various organizations interested in advancing wood use in green building systems. The effort involved contacting government organizations, nonprofits, builders, architects and others who have an interest in green building and working with them to understand the value of using wood products in green building schemes. The group also worked with federal agencies both in promoting wood construction and coordinating research activities designed to investigate claims and values associated with wood as a green building material (life cycle analysis, waste reduction, advanced building systems, etc.).

After several years of collaboration the body was sunset in early 2015.
